

Valentine Bugs



Love bugs are a sign of Valentine's Day. Share God's love with this token of love.

You will need:

- Hole punch
- Messages of love written on piece of heart-shaped cardstock paper
- Pipe cleaner
- Heart-shaped pony beads
- Colored barrel pony beads.

To do:

Punch a hole in the corner of the heart-shaped message. Fold a pipe cleaner in half. Slide the pipe cleaner through the hole of the message, leaving the message at the fold. With the two ends of the pipe cleaner together, slide a barrel pony bead to the message. Next slide the heart to the barrel pony bead. Twist the pipe cleaner ends together, then separate the very ends to form the antennae of the "valentine bug."



Valentine Heart Folder



A perfect heart for holding Valentines.

You will need:

- Red paper (from the roll) sheets measuring 20" x 36"
- Stickers
- Glue
- Tape
- Marker

To do:

Fold the paper the long way so that you have made a 10" by 18" rectangle. Cut a half circle across the top of one end of the fold. Then fold in half the short way. Put the new fold at the top of your table with the half circle cuts down. Take each corner top and fold to the center just as if you were making a newspaper hat. This fold makes two triangles. Fold the bottom edge of the paper to the line made by the triangles. Cut the outside fold of the triangles to about the same distance as the folded edge from the bottom so that you can make one more fold. Notice how you now have an upside down heart. Fold the flaps made from the last fold behind so that the edge is straight. Tape these flaps in place. Turn the heart right side up and round off the half circles if necessary. Decorate with stickers and drawings. What a neat place to keep all of those Valentine greetings!
