

## All Saints Super Cape

On all Saints day we are all called to reflect on the special gifts we have received from God and how we share them with others. Ask the children to think about their gifts and how they can share them with others to be super saints.

### *You will need:*

- Large brown grocery bags
- Markers
- Scissors
- Yarn

### *To do:*

One brown grocery bag will make two capes. Cut out the two large panels of each bag. Round off the narrower top of each rectangle. Punch 2 holes on each of the rounded sides about 2" from the edge. Lace heavy yarn or ribbon through the 4 holes.

With marker print, "Super Saint (the name of child)" on the back of the cape. Let the children decorate the rest of the cape with markers. While all are wearing their capes, say a special prayer and ask for God's blessing on each child.
