

SS MARY, MARTHA, AND LAZARUS, HOSTS OF OUR LORD

Mary, Martha, and Lazarus were brother and sisters who lived at Bethany, and were hosts to Our Lord when he visited there (Lk 10:38-42). After the resurrection, tradition says

that the three went to Gaul (modern France) to serve as missionaries.

Here are some “goodies” you can make when you are the host for someone.

**Fudge**

- 6 oz. cream cheese
- 1 c. nuts
- 4 c. powdered sugar
- 1 tbsp. vanilla
- 4 oz. bittersweet chocolate, melted

Mix all ingredients. Spread in a lightly buttered dish or drop from spoon on waxed paper. Cool before eating.

**Pecan Cheese Logs**

- 6 oz. cheddar cheese, grated
- 8 oz. pkg. cream cheese
- ½ tbsp. garlic salt
- 3 oz. pecans, finely chopped
- paprika

In a large bowl, soften cheeses. Add garlic salt and pecans, and mix with hands until extremely well blended. Refrigerate until firm again. Roll into large log. Sprinkle paprika generously on waxed paper and roll log in paprika. Dampen hands slightly and roll log between hands until the paprika gives a red coating to the log. Refrigerate until hard. Slice in thin rounds and serve with crackers.
