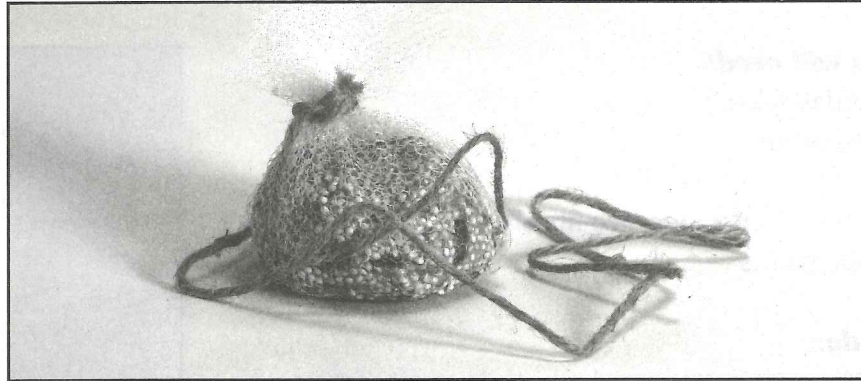


Bird Peanut Butter Cup ☺ ALL

Remembering our feathered friends in the winter when food is scarce is another way to share our blessings.

☐ **You will need:**

- Peanut butter
- Birdseed
- Nylon net
- String



☐ **To do:**

Mix a cup of peanut butter and a cup or more of birdseed together. The mixture should be very thick and as dry as possible without being crumbly. Divide the mixture into fourths and roll into balls. Place each ball in an 8" circle of nylon net. Gather the net at the top and tie with a string.

Bird Feeder Perch ☺ ALL

Caring for God's creatures also shows respect to all living things. This bird feeder is a simple project any child of any age can do as a sign of respecting life.

☐ **You will need:**

- Clear vinyl plastic plant liners
- Twigs (or drinking straws)
- Hole puncher

☐ **To do:**

Punch holes around the edge of the plant liner tray. Slide the twigs or drinking straws through the holes forming perches for the birds to stand on as they eat. Hang the feeder by tying three strings to three different holes. Bring the three strings together and secure them together in a knot. Hang from a tree branch and fill with birdseed.

☐ **More to do:**

Decorate the plastic dish with permanent markers.
